## The Rules and Video Guidelines

- Videos should not exceed 2 minutes
- Videos may not be animations (cartoons)
- Videos must be shot live
- Videos must be shot with a cell phone
- Students must make videos that express why it is important for students to participate in math competitions.
- Videos will be judged in 3 Grade Level Categories (1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>)
- Videos should be submitted via WeTransfer.com to us at [mathfestcompetition@gmail.com](mailto:mathfestcompetition@gmail.com) no later than July 12, 2020.
  - Suggested cell phone editing apps: Animoto Kinemaster Power Director You Cut Video editor & video maker Film club Tips! \*remember to hold your phone horizontally when filming. \*watch your background, find backdrops with pictures or color on them, (no white walls) \*keep your production small for safety measures (no more than 3 or 4 people) \*actors wearing masks is okay (Safety First)
