



## **SECOND GRADE PRACTICE PROBLEMS**

Below is a sample of second grade math problems showing the level of difficulty that students can expect to see at the competition events.

1. Which number is the same as 2 hundreds plus 6 ones?
2. What does  $700 + 24 + 5$  equal?
3. Add  $35 + 15$
4. Charla read 36 books. Susan has read 27 more books than Charla. How many did Susan read?
5. John had 44 baseball cards. His sister took 5 cards. How many are left?
6. Tom tried to add 124 and 153 on a calculator. What should his answer be?
7. Terry bought 6 postcards and 9 birthday cards. How many cards does he have altogether?
8. Which number is 15 more than 35?
9. Nick sold 17 posters. Jay sold 12 posters. How many more poster did Jay sell than Nick?
10. Barry has \$67. He buys a table for \$45. How much money is left?
11. Jerry bakes a pie. AT 2:30, he needs to cook the pie for 25 minutes. What time will the pie be done?
12. There are 123 students in the store and 234 outside. How many altogether?
13. Write the next number in the pattern? 6, 10, 14, \_\_\_\_\_
14. What is  $124 - 30$ ?
15. Eight kids want to eat pizza. There are 4 pieces in each box. How many boxes are needed?
